



The **Construction Laborer**, will be responsible for cleaning and preparing construction sites for the erection of structures and buildings. Unloads and loads materials, read plans and specifications, tends machines, and assists construction site workers. This position does physical labor on construction sites or in Steel shop.

Responsibilities:

- Load or unload construction materials and equipment.
- Prep construction sites by cleaning obstacles and hazards.
- Use power tools and machinery when needed.
- Help with setting up and transferring temporary structures.
- Follow instructions from supervisors to perform manual labor tasks.
- Assist skilled tradespeople in their duties.

Job Requirements:

- Maintain strict adherence to safety rules and regulations. Including but not limited to wearing safety equipment such as safety glasses, face masks, gloves, work boots, harnesses and/or other required PPE relevant to job site.
- Reliable transportation.
- Possess valid identification to work in the United States.
- Ability to pass a drug screening and criminal background check.

Physical Requirements:

- Lift and carry heavy items weighing up to 50 pounds.
- Use of hands to handle, control, or feel objects, tools or controls according to a set procedure.
- Repetitive motion.
- Physical ability to climb and access steel framework, ladders, etc.

- High school diploma/GED
- Minimum 1 year of experience as a general laborer in the construction industry
