

The *Mechanic* will analyze malfunctions and repairs, builds, and will maintain construction equipment, machinery and tools. This position will operate and inspect machines and equipment to diagnose defects.

Job Responsibilities:

- Install, align, and repair industrial machinery and mechanical equipment.
- Dismantles and reassembles equipment using hoists and hand tools.
- Examines parts for damage or excessive wear.
- Perform thorough maintenance on machinery, equipment and systems.
- Read and comprehend blueprints, drawings, sketches and plans.
- Place, change out valves, install threaded piping and tubing.

Job Requirements:

- Willingness to travel as required.
- Must possess valid identification to work in United States.
- Must have ability to pass a drug screening and criminal background check.
- Knowledge of heavy industrial service materials and tools, proper handling, storage and preparation for the work site.
- Knowledge on operating equipment such as pipe machine, burning torch, grinder, porta-band machine, chain falls, and hand tools as well as mobile equipment such as fork truck, company trucks, high reach equipment and a carry-deck crane.
- Maintain strict adherence to safety rules and regulations, to include wearing safety equipment, safety glasses, face masks, gloves, work boots, harnesses, and any required PPE relevant to job site.

Physical Requirements:

- Lift and carry heavy items weighing up to 50 pounds.
- Stand, kneel, bend, stoop, move in and around confined and cluttered places, and uneven areas, see and hear naturally or with correction.
- Requires using hands to handle, control, or feel objects, tools or controls according to a set procedure.
- Requires repetitive movement.
- Climb and maintain balance on steel framework, stairs, ladders and scaffolds.

Education and Experience:

- High school diploma and/or GED
- 3-7 years of Mechanic experience.
