

ROOF TOP AIR HANDLING UNIT (AHU)

A general contractor (GC) approached ShureLine Construction to help install new air handling units (AHU) in an unconditioned warehouse.

Based on a detailed inspection of the existing equipment and warehouse conditions, it was determined that the new AHU would have to be installed at ground level. Rigging plans were developed and approved by the GC and customer. The final radius was 220 feet.

ShureLine fabricated and installed support steel at ground level to accommodate the new AHU. All three AHU were installed in one day. The next phase of this project was to build the steel supports and install 5 large, new fans inside the warehouse. All fans were installed during off-shift hours to minimize impact to the customers operations.
